It's an exciting time for the HPTN as we continue making strides with targeted HIV prevention strategies. The meeting includes a superb array of speakers on timely topics. We are thrilled to welcome back Anthony S. Fauci, M.D., director of the National Institute of Allergy and Infectious Diseases (NIAID), and Ambassador-at-Large Deborah L. Birx, M.D., coordinator of the United States Government Activities to Combat HIV/AIDS and U.S. special representative for Global Health Diplomacy as two plenary speakers on Wednesday, 12 April. 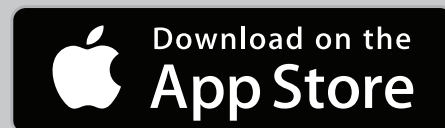

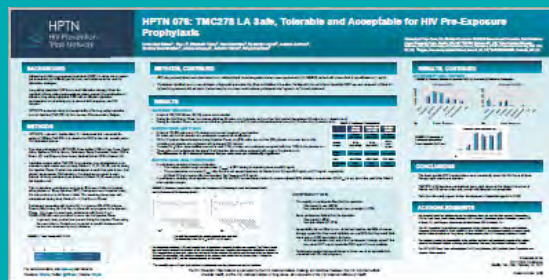

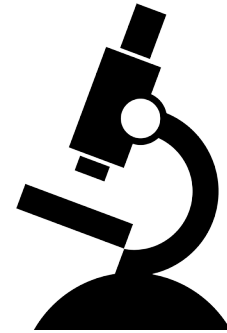
